Chapter 12

Oil Seeds and Oleaginous Fruits; Miscellaneous Grains, Seeds and Fruit; Industrial or Medicinal Plants; Straw and Fodder

Notes.

- Heading 12.07 applies, *inter alia*, to palm nuts and kernels, cotton seeds, castor oil seeds, sesamum seeds, mustard seeds, safflower seeds, poppy seeds and shea nuts (karite nuts). It does not apply to products of heading 08.01 or 08.02 or to olives (Chapter 7 or Chapter 20).
- Heading 12.08 applies not only to non-defatted flours and meals but also to flours and meals which have been partially defatted or defatted and wholly or partially refatted with their original oils. It does not, however, apply to residues of headings 23.04 to 23.06.
- For the purposes of heading 12.09, beet seeds, grass and other herbage seeds, seeds of ornamental flowers, vegetable seeds, seeds of forest trees, seeds of fruit trees, seeds of vetches (other than those of the species *vicia faba*) or of lupines are to be regarded as "seeds of a kind used for sowing".
Heading 12.09 does not, however, apply to the following even it for sowing:
 - Leguminous vegetables or sweet corn (Chapter 7);
 - Species or other products of Chapter 9;
 - Cereals (Chapter 10); or
 - Products of headings 12.01 to 12.07 or 12.11.
- Heading 12.11 applies, *inter alia*, to the following plants or parts thereof: basil, borage, ginseng, hyssop, liquorice, all species of mint, rosemary, rue, sage and wormwood.
Heading 12.11 does not, however, apply to:
 - Medicaments of Chapter 30;
 - Perfumery, cosmetic or toilet preparations of Chapter 33; or
 - Insecticides, fungicides, herbicides, disinfectants or similar products of heading 38.08.
- For the purpose of heading 12.12, the term "seaweeds and other algae" does not include:
 - Dead single-cell micro-organisms of heading 21.02;
 - Cultures of micro-organisms of heading 30.02; or
 - Fertilizers of heading 31.01 or 31.05.

Sub-heading Note.

- For the purposes of sub-heading 1205.10, the expression "low erucic acid rape or colza seeds" means rape or colza seeds yielding a fixed oil which has an erucic acid content of less than 2% by weight and yielding a solid component which contains less than 30 micromoles of glucosinolates per gram.

Import Licensing Notes

- (1) Plants and parts of plants (including seeds and fruits), of a kind used primarily in perfumery, in pharmacy or for insecticidal, fungicidal or similar purposes, fresh or dried, whether or not, crushed or powdered as covered under TARIFF ITEM 12.11, import of which has been shown as restricted and which are not covered by the list mentioned in licensing note 3 below, may be permitted freely by the Actual Users without an import license subject to plant protection quarantine certificate. However, import of opium (papaver species), cannabis (cannabis species) and coca (erythroxyton species) shall not be permitted. This free importability shall not be applicable to the items, poppy, flowers and unripe heads of dried poppy, psyllium husk (isobgul), psyllium seed (isobgul), poppy husk and jojoba seed.
- (2) Import of Crude Drugs required for making Ayurvedic, Unani or any other system of medicine as listed below is permitted freely.

- Import permitted only from Australia, Austria, France, China, Hungry, The Netherlands, Poland, Slovenia, Spain, Turkey and Czech Republic;
 - The importer shall produce an appropriate certificate from the competent authority of the exporting country that Opium Poppy have been grown licitly/ legally in that country as per requirements of International Narcotics Control Bureau; and
 - All import contracts for this item shall compulsory be registered with the Narcotics Commissioner, Gwalior prior to import.
- (4) Import permitted for sowing without a licence subject to the new Policy on Seed Development, 1988 and in accordance with import permit granted under Plant Quarantine (Regulation of Imports into India) Order, 2003.
